FUGITIVE WANTED IN TWO STATES CAPTURED IN MISSOURI

Nashville, Tenn. – The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation today removed the latest addition to the state's Top Ten Most Wanted list after he was captured in Missouri by the U.S. Marshals Service last night.

Rico Reynaldo Fleming, 22, of Moscow, Tenn. was located and taken into custody in St. Louis. He was wanted by the Fayette County Sheriff's Office for violating his probation on charges of attempted second degree murder, two counts of aggravated assault and one count of aggravated burglary. He was also wanted out of Marshall County, Miss on one count of homicide and five counts of a drive-by shooting that occurred on Christmas morning 2011 killing a 16-year-old female. Fleming will face extradition.
